MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by President Anderson. Officers Andrews, Campbell and Mayfield were also in attendance. Directors Baumgardner and Foust are present. There are a total of 10 parents present and 9 students also.

Treasurers report is given by Renee' Campbell. There is a total of \$7445.83 in the checking account and a balance of \$571.02 in the savings account.

Minutes from the previous meeting are not available at this time.

Items of Discussion:

Spring Trip 2008 - Gatlinburg, TN May 1-4

Cost is \$305 per student due by the March Booster Meeting. Payments beginning now \$38 due at each booster meeting.

Spaghetti Supper - The total collected for the Spaghetti Supper was \$1318. Profit totaled \$1108, which is approximately \$800 down from last year. Questions asked as to why we paid 2 cafeteria workers instead of 1 like previous years, and since we have to pay them, can we expect them to work? Mr. Baumgardner will address these issues with Administration.

CCHS Competition - Total collected from the gate, Band-O-Grams, and Fries and Funnel cakes totaled \$6834. We paid the Judges \$4443 and \$1379 for Trophies. Our profit from the Concession stand was \$2500. The amount we profited from the Competition was \$2500. We will have a round table discussion regarding next year's competition in February or March of 2008.
